Announcement for Public Tender

132/33 kV substation in project

1. The Ministry of Electricity and Energy - Public Electricity Corporation, of the Republic of Yemen announce for Internationally qualified, specialized and experienced Companies to participate in Tender No.(50/2010) New 132/33 kV Substations in Yafea (Lahj) & Albayda governorates and extension of the 132/33 kV substations in Alhabilain s/s.
2. The Tender will be financed by a loan granted by the Kuwaiti Fund for Arab Economical Development as well as by contribution of the Government of the Republic of Yemen.
3. The offers should include the survey, design, manufacture, supply, installation, test and commissioning and putting into commercial operation the Works Tendered. The Tender comprise the followings:-
 - a. Buildup new 132/33 kV substation consist of two transformers (2*45MVA), 132 KV switchyards with 132 kv CBs & accessories, a lots of 33 kv switchgears, and civil works Laboos area in Lahj Governorate.
 - b. Buildup new 132/33 kv substation consist of two transformers (2*45MVA), 132 KV switchyards with 132 kv CBs & accessories, a lot of 33 kv switchgears, and civil works at Albayda in Albayda Governorate.
 - c. Extension work by adding two 132/33 kV bays to accommodate two new circuits to connect new Yafea s/s & civil works. At Existing 132 kV Alhabilain s/s in Lahj Governorate.
4. Tenders must be fully qualified and specialized and have clear and proven experience in previous similar projects.
The Tender Documents can be obtained by submission of written application to the projects PMU at the address below during working hours upon payment of a non-refundable fee of USD \$1,000. The deadline for purchase of the tender documents is 29/ 10 / 2014 .
5. A site visit will be organized for all tenderers on (07/09 - 14/ 09 /2014) to acquaint themselves with all site particulars, applicable laws and information given in the tender document.
6. Pre Bid meeting will take place at the following date, time and place : (15 / 09/ 2014), at 11 AM, Ministry Hall 1st flour Airport street – Sana'a – Republic-of-Yemen.
7. Each tender must be submitted in a red-waxed sealed envelope (two separate sealed envelopes). 1st Envelope Technical with Eligibility & 2nd Envelope Commercial. Technical Envelope shall be accompanied with unconditional tender bond for an amount of USD (450,000\$) in words four hundred fifty thousand United States Dollars, issued by an approved Bank located in Yemen. The tender bond shall be valid for (210) days from the day of opening of Technical tender.
8. The tender offer shall have validity period of (180) consecutive days from the day of opening of tenders.
9. The offers submitted shall be subject to the customs duty & the sales tax and all other taxes according to Yemeni Law.
10. Tenderers shall submit a written confirmation from the manufacturers of Plant & Equipments confirming their commitment to supply the Plant & Equipment and guarantee availability of spare parts for a minimum periods of five years.
11. Tenders submitted by local tenderers must be accompanied by copy of the tax certificate and commercial registration certificate, Insurance card + Zakaat card.
12. The Inspection Company will be appointed and paid for by the Employer.
